Please read the following before filling out your SOLO ENTRY FORM.

1. **Entry forms are due February 12, 2022.** All fees must accompany entry forms.
2. It is the responsibility of the participant to ensure the entry form is completed IN FULL and SIGNED. Please write clearly or fill out form by computer. **Incomplete forms will not be processed or returned.**
3. Use a separate form for each instrument if required. (ex. one for all vocal entries and a separate entry form for all string entries). Photocopy this form as needed.
4. Fill out Ensemble entry form for duets, trios and all ensembles or choirs.
5. Cheques should be made payable to the South Simcoe Arts Council.
6. If paying by credit card, please register online or pay in person at the SSAC office. Credit cards given over the phone will be subject to an additional fee.
7. If paying by e-transfer, send it to info@southsimcoeartscouncil.com and please write "Music Festival [performer name]" in the message. SSAC is registered for auto deposit. If your bank requires a password, please use "Music2022"
8. Participants must indicate whether they prefer to perform live (in front of an adjudicator) or virtually (by video submission) for EACH CLASS.
9. Requests for special scheduling requests due to possible conflicts must be written in the comment box on the entry form. We will do our best to accommodate scheduling requests, where possible.
10. **All entries Gr.1 and higher MUST include title, composer and duration of the piece being performed in each class. Musical Theatre pieces should indicate the show/movie the song is from.** Please print the information as it should appear in the programme. **Use the format: Title, Opus or Source (Composer)**
Ex. Prelude op.39, no. 19 (Kabalevsky) OR Speechless, from "Aladdin" (A. Menken)
11. It is the responsibility of the competitor to read the rules. Signature and payment of entry fee indicate an agreement to the rules of the Music Festival 2022. Rules can be found on the SSAC website.
